Our membership fee covers the administration costs of running the scheme and providing our services. Recycling levies are charged to cover the costs of collecting and recycling your share of WEEE, we calculate this based on your sales onto the market.

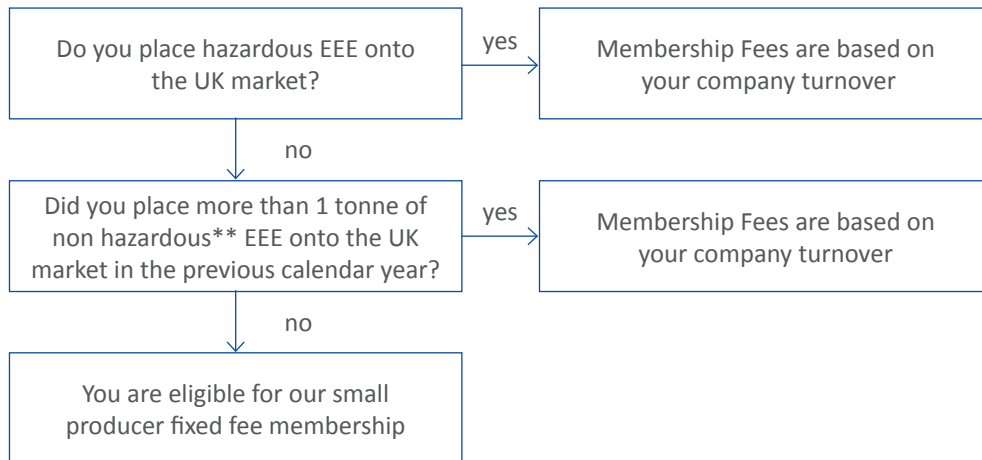

If you place less than 1 tonne of non hazardous EEE onto the UK market you are eligible for our small producer membership for a fixed fee of £250. This membership option is designed specifically with the small producer in mind; a single fee covers your membership as well as all costs for collecting and recycling WEEE, giving you full compliance at a fixed price.
